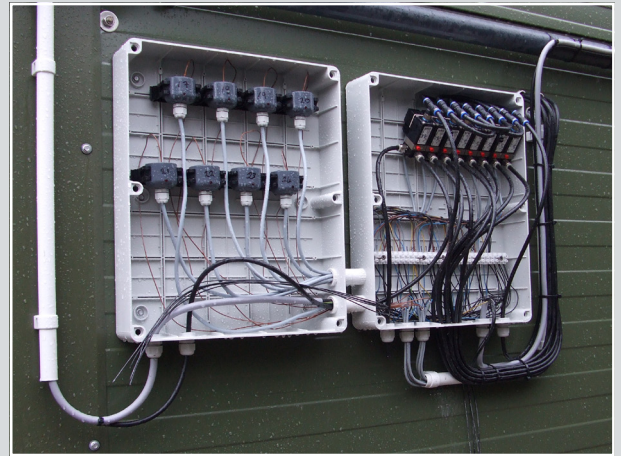


OPPORTUNITY:
